PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



KNOWING YOUR PURPOSE CREATES STRENGTH...

In my work with both individuals and organizations, I have seen firsthand the difference between “purpose driven” and “mission driven” people and companies. Purpose driven relates to the WHY, while Mission driven reflects the HOW. Big difference, and often misunderstood. In fact, one of the passions that I bring to my work and volunteerism is to help others to identify and name their purpose so that they can move in flow with change, opportunity and lead more successfully and intentionally. And, knowing your purpose (aka WHY) is more important today than ever as our businesses and families face change, opportunities and threats at an ever-increasing pace, forcing us to make decisions at breakneck speed or get left behind. Strengthening our decision-making muscles is imperative for both short- and long-term success and promoting peace and joy in our daily lives and businesses, and understanding your (and your organizations) purpose strengthens decision making.

I contend that when you are very clear on your why or purpose, it makes it much easier to make decisions, whether that be in business or your personal life. When we know our purpose, we can then measure opportunities, threats, and even daily decisions against these three questions:

1. IS THIS IN ALIGNMENT WITH MY PURPOSE?
2. WILL THIS ELEVATE MY PURPOSE?
3. IS THIS A THREAT TO MY PURPOSE?

Your answer to these three questions gives you clarity to understand the speed at which a decision needs to be made, if it will move you toward or away from your purpose, or if you need to move quickly to protect from threat or seize an opportunity. When you clearly understand and can articulate your WHY/Purpose...decision making becomes a process that is faster, more agile, and strengthens confidence, both in your own mind and heart as well as your internal and external publics.
